

CARE TIPS FOR YOUR NEW PURE NEW WOOL MEYER TROUSERS

A lot of MEYER wool trousers are washable thanks to the addition of polyester. Wool trousers made from 100% pure new wool may not be washed in the washing machine.



Everything you need to know about caring for pure new wool trousers

Trousers made from 100% pure new wool are usually not suitable for household laundry. Chemical cleaning (P) is the right choice. However, you can wash most MEYER wool trousers at home in the washing machine thanks to the addition of polyester. With wool, this is the general rule: As little movement as possible to avoid pilling (kinking due to matting) – so this means as much water as possible.

1. PREPARATION



- Sort your trousers by colour
- Do not wash your trousers made of a wool-mix fabric with other materials
- Close buttons and zippers

2. WASHING PROCESS



- Do not overload your drum
- Select a wool washing program or a gentle wash program at 40°C
- Do not spin dry, as otherwise the wool fibres will become matted
- Only use wool detergent

3. DRYER



- Our pure new wool trousers are not suitable for the dryer
- Do not knot or wring out your trousers
- If necessary, place your trousers on a towel and press the water out gently
- Smooth out your trousers and hang them out to dry

4. IRONING



- Turn your trousers back right side out before ironing
- Iron your temple at medium temperature and without steam
- To set the crease, you can place a moist cloth between the iron and the fabric
